Job Summary

In this role you will meet with CSTC and NWSRI staff prior to the start of fishing activities for an orientation session in Vanderhoof on data to be collected, recorded and reporting procedures. Inventory boat kits and restock them with missing supplies (supplies will be provided). Travel to participating communities to meet with fishers in collaboration with their designated catch monitor. Distribute Boat kits, PIT tag readers, and demonstrate how to use the Emergency Release Boat Kit materials. Record any Sturgeon encounters (seen or caught) not yet reported. You will work collaboratively with Saik'uz, Tl'azt'en, Nak'azdli, Takla, Stellat'en, Yekooche, Nadleh, Lheidli Communities.

Travel to participating communities to assist catch monitor with, or host community outreach meetings. Put up posters in community spaces (Band office, schools, community hall, post office, grocery store, gas station, College, etc).

Required Qualifications

- Strong understanding of the Mandate, Vision and Mission of the CSTC
- Demonstrated ability to work effectively independently or part of a team
- Ability to use a Windows-based computer network
- Ability to manage time and competing priorities is essential
- Strong interpersonal skills
